The Stewards received a report from the FIA Technical Delegate stating that car No. 6 was over-speeding and driven in a dangerous way when leaving its service bay after Flexi Service B and driving to TC9C (Parc Fermé IN). Evidence taken from the FIA Data logger fitted in car No. 6 confirming that the actual speed of the car was 71 kph was attached.

Pursuant to Article 49.4 of the 2015 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations, the speed of cars in the service parks must not exceed 30 kph.

The Stewards then summoned a representative of the Competitor of car No. 6 M-SPORT WORLD RALLY TEAM to them.

The representative of the Competitor, Mr. John Millington, appeared in front of the Stewards at 19:00 hrs, accompanied by Mr. Iain Tullie, Team Co-ordinator.

On being questioned, Mr. Tullie stated that due to brake problems suffered during the day, they had changed the brakes in the service. After leaving their service bay, the mechanic who was driving the car applied "left foot braking and acceleration" and must hereby have exceeded the speed limit as stated for a short distance.

They apologized for this lapse.

The Stewards, after due deliberation,

DECIDE

To impose a **fine of € 1025** on the Competitor of car No. 6 for this breach of Article 49.4 of the 2015 FIA WRC Sporting Regulations.

The Competitor is reminded of its right to appeal.


